West Linn Paper Company is located at the base of the historic Willamette Falls, just a few miles from downtown Portland, Oregon. Founded in 1889, the mill originally produced a variety of products including newsprint, creped toweling and gun cotton. In the 1940's, production shifted to the development and manufacturing of coated paper—which had a significant impact on the publishing industry in the West. In 1997, the mill was reopened as West Linn Paper Company and today we are the only coated freesheet paper manufacturer in the West.
